## What will you be responsible for

A Software Test Specialist has day to day responsibility for planning, specifying and executing the system and integration tests utilizing HPQC. The Specialist designs test procedures/scripts, executes them and reviews results from process tests in a software development life cycle. The employee will also research potential software deficiencies and work together with development team and end customer in order to find solutions.

The Specialist works in a joint team to deliver the functionality through an Agile like iterative process, ensuring accurate and auditable testware which can be used subsequently for whole system and regression testing.

The Software Tests Specialist will be engaged in:

- preparation of the tests conditions
- mapping of conditions against project requirements
- providing analysis of end-2-end business scenarios
- creation of Test Scenarios and Test Cases including test data and expected results based on documentation available in German
- executing designed tests, annotating the actual results and comparing them against expected results
- identifying discrepancies, reporting problems and obtaining sufficient evidence to enable diagnosis and correction of faults
- re-testing fault resolutions as directed by the Test Team Leader or Project Manager
- liaising with suppliers, teams and team leaders

## What do we require

- Effective communication in German and/or English
- 1+ year of documented experience in field of software testing
- ISTQB Foundation course or certificate would be desired advantage
- Reliability and precision at work.
